4.3 Consideration of Approval of LCFF Local Indicator Data Report

Action Requested:

Previous Staff/Board Action, Background Information and/or Statement of Need:

California's accountability and continuous improvement system provides information about how local educational agencies and schools are meeting the needs of California's diverse student population based on a concise set of measures. In addition to the State indicators, each LEA is responsible for reporting on local indicators that address additional local priorities. These local indicators must be approved by the Board prior to July 1, 2026. For LCFF priorities where data is not collected at the state level, LEAs will measure and report on their progress through the Dashboard based on locally collected data. This information is self-reported. There are 8 state priority areas (addressed in the LCAP, Five of those are considered "Local Indicators": Basic Conditions, Implementation of State Academic Standards, Parent Engagement, School Climate, and Access to a Broad Course of Study. The State Board of Education approved standards for the local performance indicators that support LEAs in measuring and reporting their progress within the relevant Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) priority. For each local performance indicator, the approved standard involves: (1) measuring LEA progress on the local performance indicator based on locally available information, and (2) reporting the results to the LEA's local governing board at regularly scheduled meeting of the local governing board and to the educational partners and the public through the Dashboard. LEAs determine whether they have [Met, Not Met, or Not Met for Two or More Years] the standard for each applicable local performance indicator. LEAs make this determination by using self-reflection tools included in the Dashboard, which will allow them to measure and report their progress through the

Dashboard user interface. LEAs will collect and reflect on locally available information relevant to progress on that LCFF priority, which will support local planning and improvement efforts.
